

## **Culworth Primary Academy Pupil Academic Performance 2017**

Below is a summary of our school performance from the year 2016/17. We have worked very hard in school to strive for high standards of achievement and the results are a reflection of the hard work of everyone, particularly the children. Well done for a great year.

### **Early Years Good Level of Development**

- 69% of our Early Years children achieved a good level of development at the end of their Reception Year.
- In their number work, 85% of children made expected or better progress from their baseline assessment at the start of the year.

### **Year 1 Phonics**

- 70% of our year 1 children passed their Phonics Screening at the end of the year.

### **Year 2**

- In maths, 75% of our year 2 children achieved the expected standard by the end of the year.
- In reading, 75% of children also achieved the expected standard.
- Both of these areas are above the national average for year 2 children.
- 66% of children achieved the expected standard in writing.
- All results are at or above national average for end of KS1.

### **Year 6**

- In maths, 95% of our pupils in year 6 achieved the expected standard
- 25% of those children reaching the higher standards.
- 82% of children reached the expected standard in reading and writing
- 91% of all year 6 pupils achieved the expected standard in English grammar, punctuation and spelling.
- At least 90% of children in year 6 made expected or even better progress from where they began.
- Children achieving the expected standard in all core areas (reading, writing and maths) was 78%, well above the national mark of 61%.
