Literacy

Continue to develop understanding of:

Identifying nouns, verbs and adjectives.

Identifying questions, exclamations and statements (Year 2).

Continue to develop sentence building – reinforce capital letters and full stops and develop independent checking skills. Use adjectives to make sentences interesting.

Develop knowledge of spelling patterns from years 1 and 2 and continue to develop phonic knowledge.

Apostrophes for contraction and possession (Year 2).

Unit fractions: $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{3}$ as well as $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ non-unit fractions (Year 2)
Finding $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of a shape and a quantity (Year 1).

Recall doubling and halving facts from the autumn term.

Counting in multiples of 2, 5, 10, 100 (and in 3s for Year 2).

Working on missing number calculations to reinforce skills already learnt.

Number bonds to 20 (Year 1) and related facts to 100 (Year 2).
