Dear Parents

We hope you are all enjoying half term and this e mail finds you all safe and well. We thought a quick e mail with a few reminders about return to school next week could be useful. There will be three classes/bubbles of children in school that will consist of:

1. Reception, year 1 and key worker year 2 children
2. Key worker children Years 3 4 and 5
3. Year 6 children

If your child is Rec, 1 or 2 - drop off time at the gate is 9-9.15 and they will enter through the side entrance to school where a teacher will be waiting for them. These children need to be collected at 3 pm from the playground. We have allowed 15 mins before the next set of parents arrive to minimise people in the same area.

Key worker children in years 3 4 and 5 can be dropped off at 8.45-9am and collected at 3-3.15pm. Can these children only be dropped off through the big blue gates into our car park, where they can access Mrs Clark's classroom directly. Collection will be from the playground. Please access the big gates by walking past the school around the back, past the church and not up the access road.

Year 6 children can be dropped at 8.45 and no later than 9. Collection is 3.15 from the playground, again this could take time for them to exit one at a time, so we have allowed until 3.30.

There will be no hot dinners but you can order a packed lunch for your child through Dolce website as normal if you wish to do so. There is also no coach service at the minute.

We look forward to welcoming your child back. Although it feels strange, please let us reassure you that we will do everything to make these arrangements as easy as possible for your child. If you have any questions at all, please let us know
