Dear Parents and Carers

We hope this email finds you well. We have been working really hard to try and accommodate as many children back into school as possible before the end of term.

After much deliberation, we have decided to invite year 4 children back first, starting 29th June. The following week, 6th July we will be in a position to also ask year 2, 3 and 5 children to return.

Please note in order for this to happen and to make it fair for all children, our year 6's will be asked to only attend Monday to Wednesday starting from 29th June. Moving forward this will mean changes to our current bubbles and drop off and collection times may vary from the current ones.

We will ensure all areas of school are thoroughly cleaned before the implementation of the new bubbles, but please be aware it will mean some children will have to swap from the class they currently work in, in order for this new rota to go ahead.

WE ARE SORRY TO SAY WE HAVE BASED OUR ROTAS ON THOSE PARENTS WHO SAID THEY WANTED THEIR CHILDREN TO RETURN. WE ARE NOW AT FULL CAPACITY AND THEREFORE WE HAVE NO SPACE FOR CHILDREN WHO SAID THEY WERE NOT RETURNING THIS TERM.

In line with government guidance, we cannot allow parents into school, so please call the school office if you have any enquiries throughout the day. Drop off for all children is at the side black gate, where we ask parents to leave their children and then continue up the path around the back of the school to ensure a one-way system. Collection is from the playground at your child's allocated time. Please leave school at this time through the car park gates, to again implement a one-way system and ensure social distancing wherever possible. Can we remind everybody that children are only required to bring a lunch box and drink bottle, no school bags please. We currently have no way of providing hot dinners, so all children need a packed lunch. Government advice is for a new, clean uniform each day. If you need to send your child into school, on the odd occasion, in normal clothing whilst their uniform is being washed, this is absolutely fine.

We once again thank you for your continued support. We are so pleased we have managed to find a way to ensure all children get some schooling before the end of term. We look forward to welcoming you and your children back.
